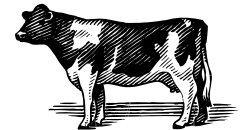

- **SHOW THEIR OWN ANIMALS.** See the New York State Fair Youth Premium Book. With valid reason, prior arrangements may be made with the Youth Dairy Cattle Superintendent for another youth to show an animal. **Please note:** Sports and/or work are NOT acceptable reasons.
- **HAVE ANIMALS REGISTERED** with the **NATIONAL ORGANIZATION** of the breed. **No papers pending.**
- **Have ANIMALS INDIVIDUALLY OWNED-NO JOINT or FARM OWNERSHIP OF ANIMALS FOR YOUTH SHOW**
- **SUBMIT A SEPARATE ENTRY FORM FOR OPEN SHOW**
- **SHOW ALL INFORMATION EXACTLY AS IT APPEARS ON REGISTRATION PAPER. PLEASE INCLUDE A COPY OF BOTH SIDES OF REGISTRATION PAPER(S).**

• **ENTRY DEADLINE - AUGUST 11, 2008**

- Be sure that you referred to the State Fair Youth Premium Book for your Class Numbers (don't use County numbers!:) available online at <http://www.nysfair.org/competitions> under 4-H Youth Livestock, General Information and Rules.
- If you need to enter more animals than there is room for on this entry blank, use additional entry blanks (can use just first page) and **staple or paper clip** together **ALL** Dairy Cattle entry blanks from the same exhibitor.
- Once completed, return this entry blank to your 4-H or youth organization office so it can be processed in time for the State Fair entry deadline of **August 11, 2008**.
- Check with your 4-H agent or authorized representative to be sure that you are covered with accident and health insurance!

Requirements: 4-H or Youth Organization Representatives:

- Please send **ORIGINAL** completed entry blanks and signed "Conduct Form" to: Entry Department, New York State Fair, 581 State Fair Blvd., Syracuse, NY 13209 **OR**
 - Check here** if entries are **submitted electronically** using the website: www.nysfair.org/competitions under 4-H Youth Livestock.
- Please send **PHOTOCOPIES OF BOTH SIDES** of the completed entry blank, and **registration papers, plus** signed "Conduct Form" to: Eileen Taylor, 297 Botcher Road, Newark, NY 14513 (Telephone: 315-331-7478).
- **Original health papers** need to be in the hands of exhibitors upon unloading cattle at the State Fair.

NOTE: As of the 2008 fair season, all cattle exhibited at NY County fairs or State Fair must be negative to an approved test appropriate to detect Bovine Viral Diarrhea persistent infection (BVD-PI).
